

Black History Month

Amanda Gorman

Born and raised in Los Angeles, California,
Amanda Gorman developed a love for writing. She
went on to attend Harvard and earned a degree in
Sociology. She is a Barnes and Noble Writers for
Writers Award recipient and is the first National
Youth Poet Laureate, as well as the United States'
youngest inaugural poet. Some of her well-known
works include Change Sings, The Hill We Climb and
Other Poems, and The One for Whom Food Is Not
Enough.





Estelle Massey Osborne

The first Black woman to earn an MA in nursing and the first Black member of NYU's faculty, Estelle Massey Osborne is honored as a champion of education and nurses' rights. She advocated for other Black nurses' access to higher education and significantly expanded the number of nursing schools that would accept Black students.



Membership Requirements

Due to the current state of the COVID-19 situation, NSA has made some revisions to our membership requirements for this semester. They are as follows:

- Community Service Hours: This Spring 2021
 semester to fulfill active membership
 requirements volunteers need to earn a total of 5
 points through their choices of the activities
 listed here.
- General Meetings: Our general meetings will be conducted over Zoom and will be recorded and posted. Look out for emails containing more information regarding our meetings. Attending a meeting is not a requirement for active membership, but is recommended! Meeting minutes will be sent out afterwards.
- Membership Dues: Fall semester early dues are \$10.00, due: March 21, 2021. After the early due date, the price increases to \$20.00. Last day to pay dues is May 14, 2021.
