
NEW MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

ABOUT COVID-19

According to the CDC, COVID-19 is transmitted from close person-to-person contact (about 6 feet distance). This virus is spread through respiratory droplets and can be found on surfaces that have not been cleaned. The populations who have been identified as higher risk are: people aged 65+ years of age, individuals with chronic lung disease, people who are immunocompromised, people with serious heart problems, people with sever obesity, and pregnant women.

At this time, it is important to listen to CDC and government guidelines to help protect ourselves and our communities. California has extended the shelter-in-place order to at least May 1st. In accordance to this, USF is continuing to operate under its shelter-in-place directions.

Common symptoms of COVID-19 include but are not limited to:

- Fever
- Cough
- · Shortness of breath















How to Prevent the Spread:

The CDC recommends the following in helping to decrease the spread of the virus:

- Avoid being in close contact with those who are sick
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds
- Use an alcohol based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol content
- Avoid social gathering of 10 or more people
- Avoid nonessential traveling
- Work and/or study from home if able to

What to do if you are sick:

- Stay at home unless for going out for medical care
- Isolate yourself from others, including those in your own home
- Avoid sharing personal items (dishware, utensils, towels, etc.)
- Call ahead before visiting your doctor
- Wear a facemask
- Cover your coughs and sneezes
- Wash/clean your hands often
- Clean surfaces often, especially ones that are often touched
- Monitor your symptoms and call your healthcare provider if your illness is worsening
