




## **General Meeting #1**



## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

#### **Membership Requirements**

All students who want to be considered active NSA members this semester must fulfill the following requirements:

- Community Service Hours: Students must earn a total of at least 5 points through the activities listed on our Community Service page
- General Meetings: Attending General Meetings is not a requirement for active membership, but is highly recommended and those who attend will earn 1 community service point
- Membership Dues: Pay the \$10 dues by the early deadline of October 11th, or \$20 by the November 8th deadline. Instructions on how to pay dues can be found on our Membership page
- Fundraising: Students must purchase from or attend 1 fundraising event this semester
